THE FRIENDS OF GREYSTONE PRESENT THE MARJORIE FASMAN GREYSTONE RESTORATION AWARD

In 2006, Beverly Hills resident and long time Greystone champion Marjorie Fasman bestowed a generous donation to the Friends of Greystone Restoration Committee. With Mrs. Fasman's donation, the Friends of Greystone were able to clean and restore the floor in the great dining room of the mansion, previously untouched in fifty years. Additionally, with the help of an art conservationist, the dining room's marble fireplace has been renewed to its original state.

Mrs. Fasman has lived in Beverly Hills since the 1940s and has pursued causes all her life. She was a board member of The Greystone Foundation for almost 30 years. When I asked Mrs. Fasman why she became so active in the Greystone mansion, she reminded me of the time in the early 1960s when Henry Crown, the second owner of Greystone was planning to tear down the mansion and subdivide the property. She was not going to let that happen.

We thank Mrs. Fasman for taking that stand forty years ago and for her generous donation. As the first financial contributor to the restoration campaign, Friends of Greystone named an award after her, the Marjorie Fasman Greystone Restoration Award which future recipients will receive.

RETURN OF A TREASURE

The new owner of the famed "Knoll" estate in Beverly Hills, Lucy Doheny Battson's new home after moving from Greystone in 1955, returned the beloved planter/fountain basin to Greystone. While occupying the grounds at Greystone from 1928 to 1955, the massive lead covered plaster and stoned filled basin served as an ornamental piece and planter. It graced the entrance to the gardens and was placed between the double stone staircases leading to the upper formal gardens.

At the "Knoll" the basin was placed in front of the house and transformed into a water fountain. It was set on a cobalt blue pedestal inside a pool. The rectangle shaped basin with cornered loops is supported by six lead covered lions. Two small cherubs sit on opposite sides on the edge of the basin holding their swans.

We are very appreciative of the return of this unique Greystone treasure. Other ornamental elements such as urns and metal planters were also returned.
