One year later it became known as the Junior League of Los Angeles (JLLA).

Mrs. Lucy Smith Doheny, wife of Edward L. Doheny, Jr., was President of the JLLA from 1927–1928. Lucy, her husband, and their five children moved into Greystone Mansion in September 1928.

Mrs. Lucy Smith Doheny remarried in 1935, changed her name to Mrs. Leigh Battson, was featured on the cover of the November 1935 issue of the Junior League News Los Angeles.




